¹Before reaching those portions of the agenda where Commission action is requested, members of the public will be given an opportunity to address the Commission on items of interest within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Commission and any item on the regular agenda prior to or during the Commission's consideration of that item. Members of the public who wish to speak during general public comment must submit a speaker card.

Each speaker is allowed to speak for up to one minute during general public comment and one minute of comment per agenda item, up to two minutes per meeting. In total, each speaker shall be limited to three minutes per meeting. The Presiding Officer may, however, exercise discretion to determine whether such period of time should be reduced or extended based upon such factors as the length of the agenda or substance of the agenda items, the number of public comment speaker cards submitted, the need for the Commission to conclude its business as expeditiously as is practicable, and whether the Commission is at risk of losing a quorum, among other factors. Speaker cards will be available at the back of the meeting room.
