<sup>i</sup> Members of the public will be given an opportunity to address the Commission on an item listed on the agenda prior to or during the Commission's consideration of that item. Members of the public who wish to comment must submit a speaker card, which will be available at the back of the meeting room. Each speaker is allowed to speak for up to one minute per agenda item and up to two minutes for all agenda items per meeting. The Presiding Officer may, however, exercise discretion to determine whether such period of time should be reduced or extended based upon such factors as the length of the agenda or substance of the agenda items, the number of public comment speaker cards submitted, the need for the Commission to conclude its business as expeditiously as is practicable, and whether the Commission is at risk of losing a quorum, among other factors.

<sup>ii</sup> At the Presiding Officer's discretion, members of the public may be given an opportunity to address the Commission on items of interest within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Commission. Members of the public who wish to make comment must submit a speaker card, which will be available at the back of the meeting room. Each speaker is allowed to speak for up to one minute during general public comment.
