**POLICY FOR PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS**

Members of the public will be given an opportunity to address the Commission on any item listed on the agenda before or during the Commission's consideration of that item or during the Multiple Agenda Item period for up to one minute. Those who wish to comment on more than one agenda item may be given up to two minutes during the Multiple Agenda Item period. The Commission at times must necessarily exercise discretion to determine whether such period of time should be reduced or extended based upon such factors as the length of the agenda or substance of the agenda items, the number of speakers, the need for the Commission to conclude its business as expeditiously as is practicable, and whether the Commission is at risk of losing a quorum, among other factors. **EVERY PERSON WISHING TO ADDRESS THE COMMISSION MUST COMPLETE A SPEAKER'S REQUEST FORM OR SIGN-IN ON A SPEAKER'S LIST PRIOR TO THE ITEM.**

Sign language, interpreters, assistive listening devices, or other auxiliary aids and/or other services may be provided upon request. If you challenge these agenda items in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing agenzized here, or in written correspondence on these matters delivered to this agency at or prior to the public hearing.

If you seek judicial review of any decision of the City pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.5, the petition for writ of mandate pursuant to that section must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which the City's decision became final pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6. There may be other time limits which also affect your ability to seek judicial review.
